Thus, Abhakunj welfare society was officially registered encouraging more volunteers and interns to join for the services.

Open sky learning involves instructing children outside in more pleasant conditions. Open Sky Learning is about providing children from underprivileged families with opportunities for growth and education.

Abhakunj was founded with the intention of encouraging youngsters to reach their full potential. At open sky learning sessions, instructors, volunteers, and interns teach a variety of disciplines.

The key goal of Abhakunj is to give children's and youngsters who desire to study a free and complete education. Open Sky learning classes feature

volunteers, teachers, and internship opportunities in Abhakunj. Students have shown that a push from the right mentors can make them achieve milestones.
